### Prayer Needs!

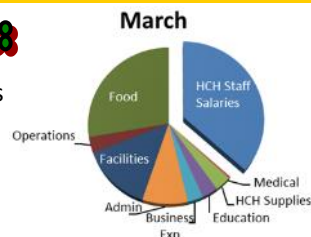
- ❖ For continued healing for Jeff and Barbara after their accident and that they can join us on our trip, as planned
